3. **MINIMUM ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS:** The student must score a minimum Grade 'D' to pass a particular course.
4. **SEMESTER GRADE POINT AVERAGE (SGPA):** The SGPA describes performance of the student in a particular semester

$$\text{SGPA} = \frac{\text{Point Secured in the Semester}}{\text{Credits registered in the semester, excluding audit and S/Z grade courses}}$$

5. **CUMULATIVE GRADE POINT AVERAGE (CGPA):** The CGPA describes overall performance for all the completed semesters at any point in time.

$$\text{CGPA} = \frac{\text{Cumulative Points Secured in all passed courses (A-D grade)}}{\text{Cumulative earned credits, excluding audit and S/Z grade courses}}$$

6. Percentage = Overall CGPA × 9.5
