- NOTE:** (The brief guidelines given below are only indicative. For details, the corresponding university notifications issued from time to time should be referred.)
- Minimum passing marks in each Theory Paper 25% of Total Examination and 50% aggregate of Two Semesters Total Examination (MCQ, or Multiple & Short Answer, Sessional, Term Test, and 45% aggregate of four semesters/subject papers).
  - Passing in the theory and 75% aggregate activities is a necessary condition for awarding marks to be awarded a total marks percentage average.
  - For Theory Paper marks, denote 'P' in the paper and 'S' in the sessional marks in the final paper to give the grand total. However, the grand total is an attempt which will neither be obtained in individual semesters, subject nor in total aggregate marks obtained. The Grand Marks will be awarded only if the student appears in all the papers/semesters in the examination.
  - Grand Marks in the sessional 75% of the aggregate marks prescribed in previous semesters for the semester the next year to be held will be awarded on a subject in the final semester in the subject passed the examination by the student in that Group/Marks.
  - Revaluation: A student may be re-examined for a given class only when having less passed subject in 25% of the theory papers and 25% of the practical/assessment subjects, respectively.
  - Revaluation: Re-examination should submit the final application form through mail of the Institute of Technology within 15 days from the date of declaration of the examination results. The application will be accepted only if the student appears in all the papers/semesters in the examination. The revaluation will be held after the final date of the application. The revaluation is not possible in the MCQ paper/assessment.
  - Re-examination: A student may be re-examined in any semester or year when a student is not appearing in the examination in the semester/Year/Class.
  - In case of any student being absent during the presentation of the marks sheet or otherwise, the University is fully responsible for the same.
  - Students whose marks are subject to the jurisdiction of the Rajasthan Technical University, Jaipur, will be subject to the laws of the state.
  - For any kind of assessment/evaluation, the student has to appear in the examination in the next year/semester.
  - Term Test: A student is allowed to improve the term test if he/she is appearing in the University Examination of that theory paper again and if being failed in a semester then after the improvement, all term test marks, the marks secured by the student in previous term test, shall beget automatically cancelled. The marks of the term test/assessment term will only be considered for marking out the result if a student is not appearing in the next year/semester.
  - Re-examination: If the student is failing in any assessment or sessional or practical, he/she can apply for re-examination in the second semester provided the student holds a minimum 50% marks in the assessment or sessional or practical in the previous semester. The student will be responsible for the term test/assessment or practical of the subject and neither marks of the other papers of the same semester shall only be considered for marking out the result. If a student is not appearing in the term test/assessment or practical, the marks shall be treated as absent.

- Notes:** (The brief guidelines given below are only indicative. For detail, the corresponding orders/notifications issued from time to time must be referred).
1. **Minimum passing marks:** In each Theory Paper 30% in Final Examination and 40% in aggregate of Term Test and Final Examination "AND" in Practical & Sessional 30% in each component separately and 40% in aggregate of both components taken together.
  2. Failing in Discipline and Extra-curricular activities is not necessary but marks obtained therein will be counted in total marks/percentage obtained.
  3. Star (\*) shown against the marks denotes FAIL in that paper and "G" denotes Grace marks awarded in that paper to pass the examination. However, the grace marks are virtual marks which are neither to be added in individual component/subtotal nor in total/aggregate marks obtained. The Grace marks will be awarded only if, the student appears in all the papers prescribed for the examination.
  4. **Grace Marks:** In the extent of 1% of the aggregate marks prescribed for an examination (to be raised to the next whole number) will be awarded to a student in the failed subject(s) provided the student passes the examination by the award of such Grace Marks.
  5. **Promotion:** A student may be promoted to the higher class only when he/she has passed atleast 25% of the theory papers and 25% of the practical and sessional subjects, separately.
  6. **Re-valuation of answer books:** shall be permissible in not more than 25% of the theory papers (to be raised to the next whole number) in which a student is actually appeared in examination. For Re-valuation, the student must submit his/her application form (through Head of the Institute) to the University within 15 days from the date of issue of marks sheet. Incomplete application for application without requisite fee or received after the due date will be rejected. RE-valuation is not permitted in the BACK paper examinations.
  7. Answer books are not subjected to any inspection or production before any external or internal agency except at the instance of Vice-Chancellor.
  8. In case of any mistake being detected during the preparation of mark-sheet of afterwards the University is fully empowered to correct the same.
  9. All court cases shall be subjected to the jurisdiction of Rajasthan Technical University headquarter i.e. KOTA and not any other place.
  10. For any kind of improvement as per rules, the student has to apply within one month of the declaration of the result in their institutes.
  11. **Term Test:** A student is allowed to improve the term tests if he/she is appearing in the University Examination of that theory paper again and if failing earlier. If a student has applied for improvement of term tests marks, the marks secured by him/her in previous term test shall stand automatically cancelled. The marks of the latest examinations tests shall only be considered for working out the result. If such a candidate has absented himself/herself from the test, he/she shall be treated as absent.
  12. **Sessional Improvement:** If the student is failing in any practical and/or sessional subject(s), he/she can apply for improvement in the sessional component provided the earlier marks in the sessional component are less than 40%. The student will be required to register in both practical and sessional components of the subject(s) and his/her marks of the latest practical & sessional examination shall only be considered for working out the result. If such a student has absented himself/herself from the test, then he/she shall be treated as absent.
