- Minimum passing marks in each Theory Paper 30% in Final Examination and 40% in aggregate Term Test and Final Examination "AND" in Practical & Sessional 20% in each component separately and 40% in aggregate of both components taken together.
 - Passing in Discipline and Extra-curricular activities is not necessary but marks obtained therein will be counted in total marks/percentage obtained.
 - Seat (*) shown against the marks denotes PAE in Final paper and TC - Terminal Course marks awarded in that paper to pass the examination. However, the grand marks are total marks which are called final marks for individual component/subject not in total aggregate marks obtained. The Grand percentage marked as (*) the student appears to after aggregation of the examination.
 - Grade Marks to the extent of 1% of the aggregate marks prescribed for an examination be granted to the rank of the number of write awarded to a student in the final subject/ component. The student scores the percentage by the grade of each Grade Mark.
 - Procedure: A student may be promoted to the higher class only when he/she has passed atleast in 20% of the theory papers and 20% of the practical and sessional subjects, respectively.
 - Re-valuation: If answer books contain percentages not more than 20% of the theory papers (to be raised to the next whole number) and/or a student actually appeared in examination, his re-valuation, the student must submit his/her application form (through Head of the Institute/College/University within 15 days from the date of receipt of marks sheet, irrespective of the examination, without requiring fee or reward) after the due date as per notice. The valuation is not conducted in the BACK paper examination.
 - Answer books are not subjected to any inspection or production before any external official agency except at the instance of Vice-Chancellor.
 - In case of any dispute being detected during the preparation of the marks sheet or afterwards, the University is liable to provide correct the same.
 - All cases raised are to be subject to the jurisdiction of the Rajasthan Technical University Headquarters (in state and out state) after 30 days.
 - For any sort of improvement as per rules, the student has to apply within one month of the declaration of the result in that institute.
 - Term Test: A student is allowed to improve the term test if he/she is appearing in the University Examination of that theory paper again and if being called, if a student has applied for improvement of term test marks, the marks declared by teacher in previous term test shall stand automatically corrected. The marks of the latest examination/term test shall only be considered for working out the result. If such a candidate has appeared himself/herself from the first time, he/she shall be treated as absent.
 - Sessional improvement: If the student is failing in any practical and/or sessional subjects, he/she can apply for improvement in the sessional component provided he/she marks in the practical component are less than 40%. The student will be required to register in both practical and sessional components of the subject. Marks of the latest practical & sessional examination shall only be considered for working out the result. If such a student has appeared himself/herself from the first time, he/she shall be treated as absent.

- Maximum passing marks in each Theory Paper 50% of Total Question and 60% in aggregate of Term-Test and Final Examination (40% in Practical & Sessional & 20% in extra-curricular activity) and 40% in aggregate of both components taken together.
 - Passing in Discipline and Extra-curricular activities is not necessary but marks obtained thereon will be counted in total marks/percentage obtained.
 - Mark obtained against the marks, sessional, PAB, in full paper and 20% sessional marks awarded in this paper is given the percentage provided the government is of that nature which is written to be written individual component, subject mentioned, aggregate marks obtained. The Grade mark will be awarded only if the student appears in all the papers/subjects in the examination.
 - Grade Marks for the subject of 1/3 of the aggregate marks awarded for any examination (to be rounded up to the next whole number) will be awarded to a student in the field in which provided the student passes the examination by the total of such Grade Marks.
 - Promotion: A student may be promoted to the higher class only when he/she has passed minimum 20% of the Theory papers and 20% of the practical and sessionals subjects, respectively.
 - Re-admission (re-exam): 100% marks/percentage must more than 20% of the Theory papers to be taken in the next session (number of times it is decided by the university examination). For re-admission, the student must submit the application form through Head of the Institute after University exam. There is no fee for the same. There is no provision for the re-admission of students without minimum test or practical after the due period is required. For admission in the next session, the student must appear in all the papers/subjects in the examination.
 - Revised marks are not submitted to any government or professional or other external agency except the members of the Council.
 - In case of any student having deficiency during the progression of the marks sheet or afterwards, the University is fully responsible and cannot be held liable.
 - All court order must be submitted to the University of Rajasthan Technical University, Jaipur, in the prescribed form.
 - For any court order, the student must submit the marks sheet of the subject of the deficiency of the marks sheet.
 - Term Test: Awarded is intended to increase the term test & marks appearing in the University Examination of the theory paper again and taking same if a student is unable to improve in all the term tests, the marks obtained by him/her in previous term test will also automatically cancelled. The marks of the term examinations must also be cancelled for writing out the result. If such a candidate has obtained minimum marks from the last, marks shall be treated as zero.
 - Re-examination: If the student is failing in any practical and/or sessional subjects, he/she can apply for improvement in the practical/subject provided the marks obtained in the theoretical examination are less than 20%. The student will be required to appear in both practical and sessional components of the subject and the marks of the term examination and practical examination shall only be considered for writing out the result. If such a student has obtained marks from the last, then he/she shall be treated as failed.
