- Minimum passing marks in each Theory Paper 20% in First Examination and 20% in aggregate of Term Test and First Examination (M2) in Practical & Sessionals 50% in each component (Theory and 50% in aggregate of both components taken together).
 - Marking in Discriptive and Extra-curricular activities is not necessary but marks obtained therein will be counted in total marks/percentage secured.
 - Star (*) is shown against the marks secured. FAIL in the paper and 0% denotes Gross marks awarded in that paper to pass the examination. However, the gross marks are actual marks which are verified to be added in individual component. Subject to internal aggregate marks obtained. The Gross marks will be awarded only if the student appears in other papers prescribed for the examination.
 - Gross Marks to the extent of 1% of the aggregate marks awarded for an examination (as is stated in the roll sheet number) will be awarded for students who failed subject(s) provided the student appears for re-examination by the end of each Gross Marks.
 - Re-examination is allowed only for students who have failed to secure 20% of the theory papers and 20% of the practical/exercise/and/or projects. However, the re-examination of answer books shall be permissible in not more than 20% of the theory papers to be referred to the re-examination in which a student is actually appeared for examination. For re-examination, the student must appear for the examination from (through Head of the Institute) to the University within 15 days from the date of issue of marks sheet. (In case of absence of an institution, within 15 days from the date of issue of marks sheet will be required). The re-examination is not permitted in the BACK paper examination(s).
 - Answer books and all supplements and/or question bank (published before any semester or interim papers) except the Roll Sheet of Viva-Vocational.
 - In case of any marks being awarded during the preparation of the marks sheet or afterwards, the University will be empowered to amend the same.
 - All cases shall be subject to the conditions of the Rajasthan Technical University regulations. i.e. Final and final only other than.
 - In any kind of improvement as per case, the student has to apply with the record of the possession of marks in their entries.
 - Term Test: A student is allowed to improve the term test marks appearing in the University Examination. If the theory paper/subject mark is failing, then the student has applied for improvement of term test marks. The marks secured by student in previous term test, shall stand automatically cancelled. The marks of the latest examinations (term test) will only be considered for working out the result. If such a student has appeared re-examination from the last term before must be treated as above.
 - Re-examination: If the student is failing in any practical and/or sessional subject(s), student can apply for improvement of the practical component provided the student marks in the practical component are less than 50%. The student will be required to register in both practical and theoretical components of the subject, and further details of the latest practical & sessional examination shall only be permitted by working out the result. If such a student has appeared re-examination from the last term before must be treated as above.

NOTE: [The brief guidelines given below are only indicative. For detail, the corresponding orders/instructions issued from time to time shall be referred.]

- Minimum passing marks in each Theory Paper 30% in Final Examination and 40% in aggregate of Term Test and Final Examination AND in Practical & Sessional 30% in each assessment (theory and 40% in aggregate of both assessments taken together)
- Theory in Discipline and Extra-curricular activities is not compulsory but marks obtained therein will be marked from marks percentage received.
- Size of answer against the marks: Answer 40% in that paper and 20% in extra. (Grand marks awarded in that paper to pass the examination. However, the grand marks are actual marks which are neither to be added in individual component subject nor total aggregate marks obtained. The Grand marks will be awarded only if the student appears in all the papers/assessments in the examination.)
- Grand Marks to the extent of 15% of the aggregate marks prescribed for an examination (to be added to the respective number) will be awarded to a student in the failed subject(s) provided the student passes the examination by the award of sum Grade Marks.
- Re-valuation: A student may be provided to the higher class only when he/she has passed atleast 100% of the theory papers and 20% of the practical and sessional subjects respectively.
- Re-valuation of answer: Score shall be permissible to not more than 20% of the theory papers to be added to the mark whose number in which a student is actually appeared in examination. For re-valuation, the student must submit his/her application form through head of the Institute to the University within 10 days from the date of issue of marks sheet. (In case of re-valuation or objection without receiving the procedure after the due date will be rejected. Re-valuation is not provided in the BACK paper examination.)
- Answer sheets are not submitted to any inspection or production before any external agency except on the request of Vice-Chancellor.
- In case of any mistake being indicated during the preparation of the marks sheet or afterwards, the University is fully empowered to correct the same.
- All the cases shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the Rajasthan Technical University Headquarter Jaipur and not any other place.
- For any special improvement as per rules, the student has to apply within one month of the declaration of result in two months.
- Term Test: A student is allowed to improve the term test if he/she is appearing in the University Examination of that theory paper again and if having worked, if a student has applied for improvement. If term test marks the marks awarded by teacher in previous term test shall remain automatically cancelled. The marks of the latest examination shall only be considered for working out the result. If such a candidate has appeared himself/herself from the last, he/she shall be treated as absent.
- Sessional Improvement: If the student is failing in any practical and/or sessional subjects, he/she can apply for improvement in the assessment component provided the same marks in the theoretical component are not less than 40%. The student will be required to register in both practical and theoretical components of the subjects and he/she marks in the theory practical & sessional assessment shall only be considered for working out the result. If such a student has appeared himself/herself from the last, then he/she shall be treated as absent.
