- NOTE:** (The following guidelines given below are only indicative. For detail, the corresponding orders/instructions issued from time to time must be referred.)
- Minimum passing marks in every Theory Paper 20% in Final Examination and 40% in aggregate of Term Test and Final examination (MCQ in Practical & Sessional 50% in each category separately and 60% in aggregate in each component taken together)
 - Minimum Discipline and Extra-curricular activities is not compulsory but marks obtained in these activities will be considered in awarding of percentage obtained.
 - For Theory papers, the marks obtained in the paper and 50% of the marks in the sessional/term test will be considered in awarding of percentage obtained. For practical & sessional, 50% of each category will be considered in awarding of percentage obtained. The Grand marks will be awarded only if the student appears in all the papers presented by the examination.
 - Grand Marks in the award of 75% of the aggregate marks presented for an examination. To be listed to be awarded the result, will be awarded a pass mark in the total subject provided the student satisfies the condition by the award of each paper marks.
 - Progression: A student will be permitted to reappear only when he/she has passed at least 25% of the theory papers and 50% of the practical/professional subjects, separately.
 - Re-evaluation of answer: Books shall be permitted to the student only when he/she has passed at least 25% of the theory papers and 50% of the practical/professional subjects, separately. In re-evaluation, the student must submit his/her application form through mail of the University within 15 days from the date of result of each exam. Incomplete applications or application without requisite fee/proof after the date will be rejected. Re-evaluation is not permitted in MCQ (MCQ) papers.
 - Answer books are not returned to any inspector or production before any central or internal agency except at the instance of Vice-Chancellor.
 - In case of any request being forwarded to the re-evaluation of the marks sheet or photocopy, the University is fully empowered to commence same.
 - All exam results shall be submitted to the jurisdiction of the Rajasthan Technical University Jaipur. The University is fully empowered to commence same.
 - For any level of improvement in percentage, the student has to apply within one month of the declaration of the result of other courses.
 - Term Test - Evaluation: It should be informed the same result of where is appearing in the University Examination of that theory paper again and if having marks if a student has applied for improvement of term test marks, the marks secured by teacher in previous term test shall stand automatically cancelled. The marks of the later examinations / tests shall only be considered for marking up the result. A student is responsible for accurate record / transfer from the last term test to be marked as above.
 - Re-evaluation requirement: If the student is taking in any practical exam or sessional subject, marks can apply for improvement in the practical component provided the same marks in the respective component are less than 50%. The student will be required to register in both practical and theoretical components of the subject and neither mark of the latest practical & theoretical examination shall only be considered for marking up the result. If such a student has obtained improvement from the last term test, the result shall be marked as above.

- NOTE:** (The brief guidelines given below are only indicative. For details, the corresponding orders/instructions issued from time to time must be referred)
- Minimum passing marks in each Theory Paper 30% in Total Examination and 40% in aggregate of Term Test and Final Examination. 40% in Practical & Session work in each component separately and 45% in aggregate of both components taken together.
 - Passing in the theory and Extra-curricular activities is not necessary but marks obtained therein will be counted in total marks/percentage obtained.
 - Seat (as shown against the marks) denotes 'PASS' in that paper and '0' denotes 'Zero' marks awarded in that paper in 2013 Examinations. However, the given marks are virtual marks which will be added in individual component/subject to obtain aggregate marks obtained. The 'Zero' marks will be awarded only if the student appears in all the papers prescribed for the examination.
 - Grace Marks to the extent of 1% of the aggregate marks prescribed for an examination to be added to the total score (number) will be awarded to students who have failed in any paper/subject in the examination by the grace of the University.
 - Progression: A student may be promoted to the higher class only when he/she has passed atleast in 70% of the theory papers and 70% of the practical and sessional papers, respectively.
 - Re-evaluation of answer books shall be permissible to not more than 20% of the theory papers/05% of the practical and sessional papers, respectively. For re-evaluation, the student must submit his/her application form through head of the Institute to the University within 15 days from the date of result of the examination. The application without receipted or received after the due date will be rejected. The re-evaluation is not permitted in the SAQM paper examinations.
 - Answer books are not subjected to any re-evaluation or production before any external or internal agency except at the instance of Vice-Chancellor.
 - In case of any mistake being detected during the preparation of the marks whether or after result, the University is fully empowered to amend the same.
 - All court cases shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the Rajasthan Technical University Headquarter or any branch and other place.
 - For any kind of improvement in per rules, the student has to apply within one month of the declaration of the result from the institute.
 - Term Test: A student is allowed to improve the term test if he/she is appearing in the University Examination at that theory paper again and if being earlier if a student has scored in improvement of term test marks the marks awarded in previous term test shall stand automatically cancelled. The marks of the term examinations / tests and will be incorporated for working out the result if such a candidate has appeared himself / herself from the test. For the test to be treated as absent.
 - Seasonal improvement: If the student is failing in any practical and/or sessional subjects, he/she can apply for improvement in the seasonal component provided the marks in the seasonal component are less than 45%. The student will be required to register in both practical and seasonal components of the subjects and further marks of the subject average of seasonal examination shall only be considered for working out the result. If such a student has obtained pass/fail from the test, then he/she shall be treated as absent.
