1. Minimum passing marks : In each Theory Paper 30% in Final Examination and 40% in aggregate of Term Test and Final Examination "AND" in Practical & Sessional 30% in each component separately and 40% in aggregate of both components taken together.
2. Passing in Discipline and Extra-curricular activities is not necessary but marks obtained therein will be counted in total marks/percentage obtained.
3. Star (*) shown against the marks denotes FAIL in that paper and "G" denotes Grace marks awarded in that paper to pass the examination. However, the grace marks are virtual marks which are neither to be added in individual component/subject nor in total/aggregate marks obtained. The Grace marks will be awarded only if the student appears in all the papers prescribed for the examination.
4. Grace Marks to the extent of 1% of the aggregate marks prescribed for an examination (to be raised to the next whole number) will be awarded to a student in the failed subject(s) provided the student passes the examination by the award of such Grace Marks.
5. Promotion : A student may be promoted to the higher class only when he/she has passed atleast 25% of the theory papers and 25% of the practical and sessional subjects, separately.
6. Re-evaluation of answer books shall be permissible in not more than 25% of the theory papers (to be raised to the next whole number) in which a student is actually appeared in examination. For Re-evaluation, the student must submit his/her application form (through Head of the Institute) to the University within 15 days from the date of issue of marks sheet. Incomplete application for application without requisite fee or received after the due date will be rejected. RE-evaluation is not permitted in the BACK paper examinations.
7. Answer books are not subjected to any inspection or production before any external or internal agency except at the instance of Vice-Chancellor.
8. In case of any mistake being detected during the preparation of mark-sheets afterwards the University is fully empowered to correct the same.
9. All court cases shall be subjected to the jurisdiction of Rajasthan Technical University headquarter i.e. KOTA and not any other place.
10. For any kind of improvement as per rules, the student has to apply within one month of the declaration of the result in their Institutes.
11. Term Test : A student is allowed to improve the term tests if he/she is appearing in the University Examination of that theory paper again and if failing earlier. If a student has applied for improvement of term tests marks, the marks secured by him/her in previous term test shall stand automatically cancelled. The marks of the latest examination/test shall only be considered for working out the result. If such a candidate has absented himself/herself from the test, he/she shall be treated as absent.
12. Sessional Improvement : If the student is failing in any practical and/or sessional subject(s), he/she can apply for improvement in the sessional component provided the earlier marks in the sessional component are less than 40%. The student will be required to register in both practical and sessional components of the subject(s) and his/her marks of the latest practical & sessional examination shall only be considered for working out the result. If such a student has absented himself/herself from the test, then he/she shall be treated as absent.
